

### Arts & Cultural Attractions

Denver South is rich with arts, cultural attractions, and numerous recreation and entertainment options.

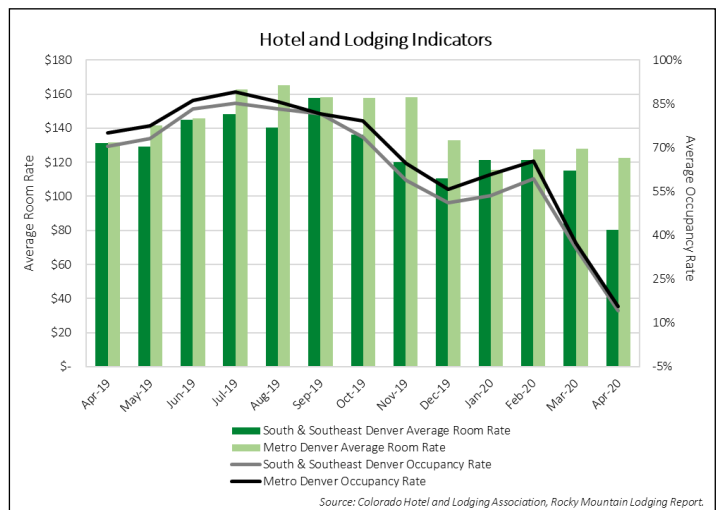
- The South Metro Corridor is home to the spectacular scenery, parks, national forests, and open space for which Colorado. The region has preserved over 50,000 acres of natural open space and is home to nearly 30 public and private golf courses in the South Metro Corridor and world-class ski resorts are located within 100 miles of the Corridor.

### Lodging

*Note: Lodging data reflects a steep drop in occupancy rate brought on by travel restrictions and stay-at-home orders that have reduced hotel occupancy significantly due to COVID-19.*

- The South and Southeast Denver markets ended the first quarter of 2020 with a year-to-date hotel occupancy rate of 49.7 percent, 10 percentage points lower than the previous year's level.
  - Metro Denver ended the first quarter with a year-to-date hotel occupancy rate of 54.9 percent, 10.7 percentage points lower than last year.
- The South and Southeast Denver market's average rental rate was \$120.00 per night year-to-date, \$2.15 lower than the same period a year prior.
  - The average room rate for Metro Denver was \$126.52 per night year-to-date, \$2.95 per night lower than the same period a year prior.
